You should have the following items in your kit:

- C3Synapse board (Figure 1)
- DVD-ROM (Figure 2)

In order to use C3Synapse board you need a PropC3 Unit and the Propeller Tool installed for Windows XP users or Brad's SPIN Tool IDE for MAC and Linux users.

Windows XP users: Follow the User's manual for all directions for downloading and installing Propeller Tool IDE MAC/Linux users: Check the link [http://www.parallax.com/tabid/828/Default.aspx]. You will be guided in installing the development environment for your MAC or Linux computer.

BEFORE HANDLING C3SYNAPSE PLEASE READ THE START GUIDE ON THE USER'S MANUAL CONTAINED INSIDE THE DVD-ROM. BE SURE TO HAVE UNDERSTOOD EACH STEP FOR MOUNTING C3SYNAPSE ON TOP OF PROPC3 BEFORE PROCEED.

STEP 2 – DVD-ROM INSTALLATION



On the DVD-ROM you will find everything you need to learn how to program your C3Synapse. The user manual explains everything in detail: hardware, software and drivers. But you might want to peruse all the directories and take a look around for yourself.

We highly recommend that you drag and copy the entire contents of the DVD to your hard drive in case the DVD is damaged or lost. Additionally, this makes it much easier to work with the files once they are all on your hard drive.

The **README.htm** will explain how to copy the DVD contents to your hard disk.
